


Since the advent of Windows Vista, the end-user experience for PCs has changed quite immensely. Among the changes that have been made is a higher security environment for users to make it easier to weed out potential problems in the long run. Unfortunately, these security settings can interfere with certain legitimate tasks, such as installing Palm-Tech inspector to your Pocket PC. This guide will explain the workaround to these security settings, should you find yourself unable to install the software to your Pocket PC.

Performing a high security Pocket PC install

1. Connect your Pocket PC to your desktop or laptop computer.
2. Click on your start button. It is the green circle in the lower-left corner of your screen with the Windows logo on it.
3. Click on "All Programs" and navigate to your Palm-Tech folder.
4. Click on the folder labeled "Version 6"
5. Click on your "Utilities" folder.
6. Click on "High Security Pocket PC Install".
7. This will bring up a black screen that tells you it is copying files to the Pocket PC. This will close automatically when it is finished.

8. Install Pocket PC software from Palm-Tech as you normally would to finish the installation. You have now successfully installed your Pocket PC software in a high-security environment.
