Our Thoughts

2GoPC:

This tablet PC is very solid, despite being from a brand with little recognition. The handwriting mechanic in the software is some of the best we've ever worked with, and the touch panel is very responsive. The built in webcam is also very good, it takes clear pictures with an adjustable resolution. The only real drawback is it uses a PATA hard drive, which is older and slower technology. Another issue is it is slightly heavier than the Eee PC, but there is a convenient carrying handle, which helps to alleviate the issue.

Asus Eee PC:

The Asus T91 is a solid computer, however it has a few features that aren't quite up to par with its 2GoPC counterpart. For example, the touch screen isn't quite as responsive and the handwriting doesn't work nearly as well as it does on 2GoPC. And on the topic of the screen, it's very glossy, which while it creates a vibrant image it also creates a challenge when trying to view it in direct sunlight. However there are numerous advantages to this unit, 2 major ones in particular. For starters, this tablet has a 16GB solid state hard drive. This means that there are no moving parts, it's super fast and energy efficient. And the other major benefit is the weight, at just slightly over 2Lbs. you can carry it around all day long and never tire of it.

HP TouchSmart:

HP is a brand that needs no introduction, and this product definitely lives up to their lofty product expectations. The screen large and vibrant, but not too glossy so direct sunlight isn't a huge issue. Also the 320GB SATA hard drive not only provides plenty of storage, but also is much faster than PATA but not quite as fast as a solid state disk, making it a nice middle ground as far as speed is concerned. The 4GBs of RAM will help in this regard as well, however, making it much more versatile in how much you will be able to perform at one time. The only real downsides here are the price, and the weight. This is a much more fully featured computer, and as such you get a full featured price tag. Also it is slightly heavier, something to think about when doing an inspection on a rooftop or other hard to access places.
