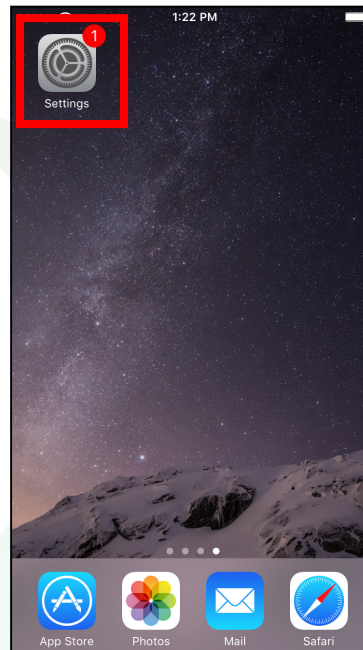

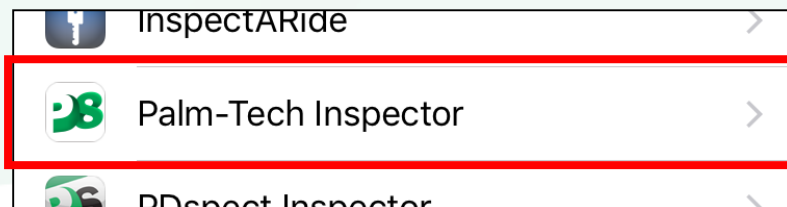
How To: SET PERMISSIONS ON AN IPHONE/IPAD

On your iPhone/iPad you have the ability to change whether or not certain apps can access your Camera and Photos. If you are seeing a black screen when you tap on the Camera or Camera Roll buttons in the app, you will want to make sure Palm-Tech is allowed to access them. This document explains how to make sure Palm-Tech has the access it needs.

1. The first step is to open the 'Settings' app on your iPhone/iPad.



2. Next, scroll down to where it is says, "Palm-Tech Inspector," and tap on it. (Note: The Settings screen on the iPad could look slightly different.)

- Now confirm that the options for both 'Camera' and 'Photos' are selected to allow access. If the button to the right of Camera or Photos is white it means Palm-Tech does not have access. So you will tap the button to make it green (as shown below) which means Palm-Tech will then have access to them.
